



TEXAS LAW SAYS

It is illegal for anyone younger than **21** to buy cigarettes, e-cigarettes, or tobacco products, and it is illegal to sell or provide cigarettes, e-cigarettes, or tobacco products to anyone under **21**.

Purchasing or attempting to purchase cigarettes, e-cigarettes, or tobacco products by a person under **21** years of age is prohibited by law. Sale or provision of cigarettes, e-cigarettes, or tobacco products to a person under **21** years of age is prohibited by law. Upon conviction, a Class C misdemeanor, including a fine of up to \$500, may be imposed. Violations may be reported to the Texas Comptroller's Office by calling 800-345-8647.

- The prohibitions on the purchase or attempt to purchase described above do not apply to a person who is in the United States Military Forces or State Military Forces.
- The prohibitions on the purchase or attempt to purchase described above do not apply to a person who was born on or before August 31, 2001.
